## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All entries must be accompanied by entry fees
2. All entries must be received by **Saturday 8th July, 2017.**
3. Entries for all events to:

4. There must be more competitors than prizes.
5. Competitors must wear official numbered cards.
6. In the event of unsuitable weather, before or on the day of the games, the competition may be cancelled at the discretion of the committee.
7. Only competitors taking part in events will be allowed in the arena.
8. Competitors in Heavy events must wear the kilt.
9. The judges decision is final.
10. **“Competitors for Novice events must have not competed in any Open Heavy Event at any Highland Games.”**
11. **Entry Fee:---**Novice Adult £5.00 for one or more events.  
Open Adult £10.00 for one or more events.

### Notes for Information and Rules of the Competition

12. Novice events 7-12 will commence at 10.00am. Open events 13 – will commence at 11.00am.
13. The Alastair MacDonald Memorial Trophy will be presented annually to the overall winner of events 7 – 12.
14. The Games Trophy will be presented annually to the overall winner of events 13 – 20.
15. The minimum qualification for each event in the World Championship Competition is as follows:

16 lb Shot	45 ft	28 lb Weight	70 feet
22 lb Ball	35 ft	56 lb Weight	30 feet
16 lb Hammer	115 ft	56 lb Weight over the bar	11 feet 6 ins
22 lb Hammer	90 ft	13 ft Caber	SGA Rules 88 and 92 (a) apply

16. A competitor must have attained the minimum qualification in the past 18 months during a recognised competition.
17. Competitors may compete only in events in which they qualify. If a competitor qualifies in five of the seven qualifying events – not Caber – he/she may compete in all events unless SGA rule 92(a) is invoked.
18. Championship points will be awarded only to competitors who compete in and attain the minimum standard in at least five of eight heavyweight events, which make up the championship.  
Competitors who compete in less than six events, or who fail to attain the minimum standard in at least five events, will be entitled to the prize money they win in events in which they compete, but will not be awarded any championship point. That is to say, if a non-qualifying competitor is third in a event, he/she will be entitled to third place money but the next qualifying competitor will take third place points, the next again taking fourth place etc.
19. In addition to prize monies, the Games Salver and £150 will be awarded to the World Heavyweight Champion.
20. Runner Up will also receive a Salver and £130.
21. Third place athlete will also receive a Salver and £95.
22. All athletes must remain in designated areas when not in competition  
**( This is a Health & Safety Requirement).**
